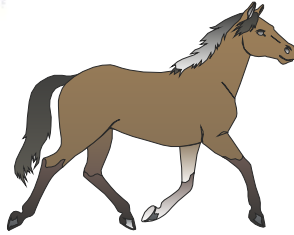

! President/Fund-raising:

! Gymkhana: Victoria and Heidi will begin ordering prizes.

! Advisor: Parades went well and morale seemed high over Frontier Days.

! Royalty:

" Packets are ready for 2005 contestants.

" Current royalty parents need to help with donations for the raffle and silent auction at the awards banquet.

" A mandatory clinic will be held at CST arena for all interested candidates on Friday Sept. 10 at 7:00 p.m. Young ladies will need to bring their horses. This will cover expectations and sample patterns.

" The clothing and makeup clinic is scheduled for August 26 at 6:30 at the CST clubhouse.

" The riding competition will be held on Sept. 25 at 10:00 at the CST arena. The luncheon and speeches will follow at 2:30 at Avantes.

! Maggie reported on events from Frontier Days. Royalty participated in Parades, Drill, the Queen's Luncheon, Coronation for Miss Frontier and grand entries for the rodeos.

! Shelby reported on her participation in Laramie County Fair. She exhibited in horse, dog, chickens, rabbit, cooking and sewing.

! Drill Team: Pointe Frontier sent a thank you for the performance in July. They are still interested in us doing a walk through drill at their facility to show how we practice for the events. The next practice will be Sunday at 11:30.

! 3-D: The fall series begins Tuesday, August 24, with registration at 6:30 and races at 7:00. Awards from the spring series will be given at the first night. Age divisions for barrels are: 12 and under - PeeWee, 13-18 - Youth, 19 & over - adult. Poles are open.

OLD BUSINESS:

! The banquet will be October 16 at the Sheriff's Posse. Deadline for the Sheila Vossler award, Easterwood award and Most improved Rider Award is October 1.

NEW BUSINESS:

! If unable to confirm judging for Saturday's show with Kaycee, she will contact another judge.

! Showing a horse in exhibition, not to be judged, will not disqualify the horse for the novice horse division the following season. These individuals will be run with the adult class.

! Approved the purchase of more ribbons for horse shows and gymkhanas.

! Decided to cater the main dish for the annual banquet this year. All members will be asked to bring either a salad or dessert.

! Discussed the need to have a major sponsor for CST and the CST drill team to continue performing at Frontier Days. Though Deb Seiloff had previously offered to do fund raising, a drill team member should be involved with this also.

! The building will need to be winterized following the royalty tryouts. Brent Kindsvater has done this in the past and is looking for volunteers to learn the routine for future years. If interested please contact Brent or Heidi.

! Phil has three metal barrels that are in better condition than our current set. He will bring them to the 3-D barrels on Tuesday evening. Heidi has volunteered to paint them with auto paint.

! Phil has a copy of the current rental agreement used at the Sheriff's Posse and a schedule of upcoming rental dates. Phil will be the contact person for new rentals.

! The trail ride is set for August 29. More details will be posted in the newsletter if Stacey can get them soon enough.
