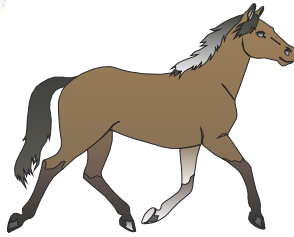

Meeting was called to order at 7:00

! President/Fund-raising:

" Phil suggested using CST arena as a trailer storage/practice area and charging rent. He will check with the city to see if this violates our lease. Approved as long as it does not violate our lease.

" Approved using the crow's nest as a premium sponsor location. Any sponsor donating \$500.00 or more would be able to have their sign posted here. The Martinez Plumbing will be placed on the crow's nest.

! V.P.: The shows, gymkhanas and 3D Barrels have been going very well. Thanks to everyone for their hard work.

! Secretary: No report

! Treasurer: Current balance is not available, but will be posted in the newsletter.

Approved a purchase of a used laptop, provided we can purchase a working one from the state surplus for under \$200.00.

! Horse Show: Proceeds from last horse show were \$650.00 less the \$185.00 for judges. Horse Show etiquette will be enforced at all events. Unsafe horses will be asked to leave the arena. Approved a budget of \$4,000 for year end awards. Year end awards will be awarded to members or non-members this year. This will be discussed in January as a possible change to the rules for next year.

! Parades: There is one more parade clinic. All riders under the age of 18 must attend a parade clinic or have a parent/adult walk with them in the parade.

! Gymkhana: We need volunteers for the gate. Multiple people are needed, especially on hot days.

! Clinics: The clinics went well, even though they were not well attended. Victoria is lining up a 4-H examiner to test our members for hunter/hack.

! Decided to keep a CST record book for fastest time in gymkhana/3-D events.

! Concessions: Hamburgers will be served on Saturdays. Royalty will help in the coke trailer while Sherry is cooking these. Jay will check the grill to see what it needs to get it working. The concession stand will close prior to the end of the shows/gymkhanas.

! Grounds: The clean-up scheduled for July 10 was cancelled. A new date needs to be set. Suggested having a grounds team with scheduled dates to work the arena and have a standard operating procedure for maintenance.

! Advisor: Everyone seems to have great morale this year. There have been no complaints.

! Audit: This is complete, with no problems surfacing.

! Royalty:

" Maggie attended 4-H Horse camp last week. They worked on horsemanship, showmanship and did a trail ride with a camp out.

" Shelby helped with the mini-campers at the cub scout camp last week. She will be attending the state horse judging competition in Riverton next week.

! Drill Team: Drill will be performing in Encampment this Saturday.

! 3-D barrels: Four nights have been completed, with a profit of \$670.00. We will give awards for one place.

OLD BUSINESS:

! Diane Steele and Kathi Carey presented information about the trail ride scheduled 8/29/04. They have chosen a route that leads to a water source and back. We will need to post a person or at least a sign stating trail ride in progress at the road entrance. We will have a carry-in lunch following the ride. Trail rules will be discussed prior to beginning the ride.

NEW BUSINESS:

! Decided to move the east alley panels 30 feet further east. This will allow a place for participants to watch events. Decided to park the coke trailer further back so people in the crows nest can see who is lined up for their event.

! Decided to have porta-potties at the upcoming shows. CST will reimburse Phil for the expense from last show.

! Heidi, Victoria and Jody will send results to the newspaper.

! Drill team will perform for Pointe Frontier on Tuesday July 20.
