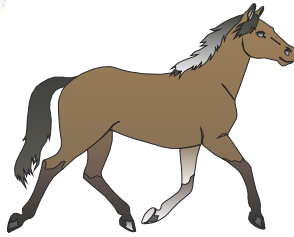

Reminders for Horseshows and Gymkhanas

It is important for safety that all horses remain at a walk on CST grounds except in the practice arena, trail course, round pen and show arena. Concessions are located in the coke trailer by the bleachers. For safety reasons and in respect for our spectators, we ask that all horse be kept out of this area. We would also encourage those who have horses that have been known to kick, to place a red ribbon on the tail of the horse. This will help warn others to keep some distance.

Arena etiquette:

Please be respectful to others in the arena. There should always be at least one horse length between horses. If passing someone, please pass to the inside of the arena. During Equitation classes, please line up on the rail when finished with your pattern, and refrain from conversation. When practicing please be aware of other riders to avoid collisions.

Bonus Registration:

Register, within the bonus time, for four or more classes in one discipline (English, Western or Gymkhana) and receive a free class in that discipline. Bonus registration for English is 7:15 - 7:30, Western 10:00 - 10:30, Gymkhana 12:00 - 12:15.

Gate Calls:

During shows and gymkhanas at least 2 gate calls will be made. Please respond to these. If a tack change is required, please let the chair person know. When the first division for a class is called, the class closes. This means no adds/drops. If the horses and riders are not at the gate by the final gate call, they will not be admitted to the class. This is to show respect for all showing and racing, in order to keep things moving.

Ribbons and Placing for past and Current Events:

At each show/gymkhana, the placings of the past dates will be posted. If there are any questions, please let us know. Ribbons are available for all classes. If you would like your ribbons, please come to the crows nest during break-times to obtain them. We will not be handing them out during the show, as some people don't want their ribbons.

Year End Awards:

Requirement for awards are for English: participation in a minimum of 8 classes. Western: minimum of 10 classes. Gymkhana a minimum of 8 classes. Halter, Exhibition, Jackpot and Training there will be no additional awards.

Lead Line for Horse Show: minimum of 3 classes and for Gymkhana is 8 classes.

May Membership Meeting 5/19/04

Meeting was called to order at 7:00

! Minutes of 4/21/04 were approved

! **President:** The lease was signed and runs through 12/31/2005.

! **Sponsorship:** The city will allow us to place signs on the chain link fence between the arena and Converse Ave. for events only, and they must be facing away from the street.

! **Vice President:** Michelle made a quilt to be raffled off. She suggested each member be given tickets to sell. Tickets will be available at the horse shows and gymkhanas. She may make another quilt to use as a drill team fundraiser. Funds from the second quilt would be used for drill team expenses.

! Michelle asked that meeting and event times be listed in the newsletter.

! **Secretary:** Currently we have approximately 30 active members. Please remind past members to attend the shows and renew their memberships.

! **Treasurer:** The checkbook balance is \$1,342.14. This does not include funds from the Easterwood or 3-D Barrels. The added revenue will bring the total to over \$2,000.00.

! **Horse Show/Gymkhana:**

" Victoria will print class descriptions prior to the May horse show and gymkhana.

" An open training English class will be added as a non-point class. The fourth English point class will be an Extended English Equitation class. This will give us the ability to offer a free class to anyone signing up for all four English classes within the first 15 minutes of registration.

" Each class will be closed at the first gate call for that class.

" Jackpots for each class will be offered and run at the end of that class. Cost of jackpots will be \$5.00, \$1.00 will go to CST the remaining \$4.00 will go into the jackpot. Leadline jackpot will remain \$2.00. Exhibition classes will be offered for any independent classes, i.e., trail, reining and extended English equitation.

" **Help with gates & set-up at shows/gymkhanas would be greatly appreciated!**

" Victoria will get the gymkhana rules and have them posted at gymkhanas.

! **Clinician:**

" Two parade clinics will be offered; June 11 and July 16, both at 6:00 p.m. This is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for anyone planning on participating in a parade. This will be a FREE clinic.

" Colleen Hall will teach a barrel clinic, the tentative date is July 21 at 6:00 p.m. This will be a FREE clinic.

" Horsemanship clinics will be held June 12 & 13. Cost of these clinic will be \$10.00/day or \$20.00/weekend for members, and \$15.00/day or \$25.00/weekend for non-members.

- Michelle Martinez will teach an equitation class (English or Western) June 12 from 9:00 - 12:00. A jumping class will follow from 1:00 - 2:00.
- Victoria Jackson and Chelsey Ingersol will host a showmanship/horsemanship/equitation class on July 13 from 9:00 - 2:00.

! **Concessions:** Voted to have Sherry purchase bird/mice proof containers to store food for shows. The coke trailer will be at the horse shows & used for all concessions. Any person leaving a tab unpaid will not be allowed to register for the next show until the tab is cleared.

! **Grounds:** Jay asked for a current sponsorship list to determine which signs to take down and which to leave posted. He also requested authorization to purchase bolt, washers, round-up, fill tube for the toilet and mouse traps. Phil will try to get these items donated.

! **Advisor:** No report.

! **Royalty:** Maggie & Shelby presented a report on their recent KGAB radio appearance. Suggested Phil take the royalty when requesting donations. Royalty will also be assisting at the horse shows and gymkhanas, especially with the concessions.

! **3-D Barrels:** The first 3-D barrels had a profit of \$127.00.

! **Parades:** Heidi has the Frontier Days application. Guidelines for parades will be listed in the newsletter. Albin, Burns and Pine Bluffs parade dates will be posted.

! **Audit:** Jolene, Stacey and Michelle will complete the audit.

! **Old Business:**

" Boni will try to list the horse show, gymkhana and 3-D barrel results in the newspaper.

" Super Day conflicts with a horse show date, so we will not have a booth.

" Phil is working with Diane Steele to set up a trail ride. Potential date - August 29.

! **New Business:**

" Tack will need to be legal for all horse shows. These requirements will be posted.

" Approved a sponsorship of the Laramie County 4-H Horse Judging Team for \$80.00.
