This clinic is required for anyone wishing to carry a flag in the Frontier Days parades and is strongly encouraged for everyone planning to ride in the parades.

May Membership Meeting
06/15/05

Meeting was called to order at 7:12 - Minutes from the May meeting were approved.

REPORTS:

- **President:** Apologized for delays in the building process. We have been focusing on small items that are easily fixed.
- **Vice President:** Request members to find a board member if they are having a conflict, complaint or problem with another member. The board member should intervene in the conflict.
- **Secretary:** No Report
- **Treasurer:** Not available
- **Horse Show:** Profit for the first three horse shows is \$1,664.44, after expenses of ribbons and judges. The past show had a profit of \$664.00. Decided to order buckles now without setting a budget for the rest of the prizes.
- **Gymkhana:** The make-up day for the June 11 rain day will be July 3.
- **Concessions:** Profit for the year has been \$260.00, profit from last weekend was \$9.00. This includes a large purchase of items that will be used at future events.
- **Grounds:** Jay presented receipts for tractor repairs.
- **Advisor:** Asked for a notice in the newsletter regarding sportsmanlike conduct. She will audit the horse show, gymkhana and financial records.
- **3-D barrels:** The fall series will begin August 16. Registration will be at 6:00, races start at 6:30. The barrel positions will need to be marked prior to this and rocks cleared from the arena.
- **Royalty:** Sammy talked about their trip to Denver to purchase more clothes. Erin talked about her English riding and how it improved both her and her horse's abilities.
- **Royalty Advisor:** Commented on how nice it is to take the royalty places.
- **Parades:** The parade clinic has been rescheduled for July 10 at 3:30 p.m. Any person wishing to carry a flag in the Frontier Days parades MUST attend this clinic even if they have carried the flag previously.
- **Rules:** No report
- **Drill Team:** Encampment is this weekend. All 18 drill team members will be in attendance. Friday, June 24 we will perform in Pine Bluffs and will also post the flag for the beginning of the rodeo. Upcoming practices are 6/22 6:30 p.m. at Frontier Park, 6/30 6:30 p.m. at CST arena, 7/10 1:00 at CST arena.
- **Sponsorship/Fundraiser:** Deb is working on getting lumber and concrete donated.
- **Web Site:** Check for updates.

OLD BUSINESS:

- The license paperwork for the radios has not been completed.
- The Knot & Trot 4-H horse show has been postponed until next year.

NEW BUSINESS

- Approved the purchase of a belly dump of gravel for the building parking lot, if finances allow.
- Scheduled work days for Sunday 6/26 1:00 to 4:00, Saturday 7/2 all day, Sunday 7/10 1:00 (during drill practice), Saturday 7/16 (during the show) and Sunday 7/17 (during the gymkhana).
- The rug for inside the back door has disappeared. Donations of rugs or carpet remnants would be appreciated.
- Frontier Days Parades: All participants must be in line by 8:45.
- The tractor has a broken part (small budget item). Jody may have one, if not Jay will have one fabricated.
- Jay is in discussion with the City regarding ownership of the old Saddle Tramps building and the fence between the CST and the greenway path. Discussed possibly needing to lease the area for one more year if we are unable to get the sand, refrigerator and other items removed this year. All would like to accomplish this before the end of the year.
- The playground that has been donated to CST does not need to be moved in June. This will be scheduled for later this fall.
- Jay recommended purchasing four prefabricated concrete mounting blocks to install some light posts.
- Heidi has had requests for royalty packets. Barb will have them ready for her prior to the next horse show.
- The July show will be another 4-H appreciation day. Heidi will take care of putting this in the 4-H newsletter. Prices will be \$20.00 all day horse show and \$10.00 all day gymkhana. Victoria requested flyers regarding this show to distribute at 4-H horse camp.
- Placings will be posted in the newsletter, points will not.
