May Membership Meeting  
05/18/05

Meeting was called to order at 7:04

- ! Minutes from the April meeting were approved.
- ! President Report: We had a lot of good comments about the first show weekend. Everyone did a great job.
- ! Vice President: Echoed President's report
- ! Secretary: No report
- ! Treasurer: Distributed an income/expense report for January.
- ! Horse Shows: Profit from the Easterwood was \$575.00, the first horse show profit was \$464.00. Discussed the need for a ring steward. Heidi asked if royalty could help with function. Barb asked that the youth trying for royalty this year be involved in this area as current royalty are expected to help with concessions.
- ! Concessions: Distributed an income/expense report. After all costs, there is a profit of \$1.53.
- ! Gymkhana: Profit after paying back the \$100.00 bank, was approx \$840.00.
- ! Grounds: Jay has a project list on the web site to direct members to areas that need addressed. Gary will continue to drag the arena Friday before show weekends.
- ! Advisor: Not available
- ! 3-D barrels: Decided to cancel the spring series as the arena will need much more sand before being ready for a 3-D series. We will discuss the fall series in July.
- ! Royalty: Sammy spoke about the Easterwood, helping with concessions and their queen wave. Erin talked about the first show weekend and a possible donation from Dr. Norwood.
- ! Royalty Advisor: The girls have been doing a good job.
- ! Parades: The CFD parade application is ready to be mailed. Decided not to attend the Greeley Stampede parade. Barb will confirm the date for Jubilee Days in Laramie. If it doesn't conflict with our July Show, the Royalty will attend, along with any other interested members. Heidi recommends car pooling to this event.
- ! The first parade clinic will be held June 5 at 3:30. There will be no charge for members but will be a \$5.00/person charge for any non-member to attend.
- ! Drill: The first walk through was Sunday prior to the Easterwood. There were 18 participants! Next practice Sunday at 2:00.
- ! Clinician: The first trail ride will be the St Judes trail ride at Curt Gowdy State Park. Paperwork is available at Oasis Market.
- ! Sponsorship/Fundraiser: Not available
- ! Web Site: no report

OLD BUSINESS

- ! Cassie from Oasis Market explained the GRASP program. Members that purchase ProChoice products through a GRASP distributor can receive a rebate and a matching rebate is given to the club. This money can be used to purchase items for the club (year end awards, etc.). Also Oasis Market give CST members a 5% discount on all purchases.
- ! The next show/gymkhana is May 28 & 29. Help from members is welcome, please see the chairperson. Approved payment for two more belly dumps of sand for the arena.
- ! Barb will print thank you cards to give to donors with a photo of the royalty. Board members will sign.

NEW BUSINESS

- ! Frank Falen suggested a roping event for kids. We would use stuffed gunny sacks that are roped and drug back across the finish line. This would be a timed event and could have a riding class and a walking class. We will place a sign up sheet at the next show/gymkhana to assess the interest level. If appropriate, this will be added in a separate area at the June show. It will be handled the same as trail is on a horse show day. Contestants will run at will, and be timed separately from the other gymkhana events.
- ! Discussed riding around the clubhouse. Decided this is permissible if there is no event at the clubhouse. Riders must stay 100 feet away from the clubhouse and follow all safety rules, including no running.
- ! Decided to allow running of horses in the fenced areas south of the arena. These areas will be marked with pink tape to identify them to members.
- ! The insurance premium raised \$434.00 due to updated information given to the agent, specifically the number of riders in the parade last year. Approved this payment.
- ! Tabled directors insurance for board members until a later meeting.
- ! Approved purchase of two additional speakers. One will be located closer to the parking area to facilitate better communication with riders at their trailers.
- ! The CD's will be allowed to roll over. Our interest to date is \$47.23.
- ! FCC requires a license for our radios, Jay will take care of obtaining this.
- ! Approved purchase of a new reel for the pole marker rope.
- ! Approved donation of \$80.00 to the 4-H judging team.
- ! Approved use of the arena by the Prairie Dusters 4-H club for a horse show, provided all insurance requirements for 4-H are met. Heidi will find these requirements and assure they are met. She will also check requirements for participants to be 4-H members.
- ! Boni has contacted Miss Rodeo Wyoming regarding a clinic for CST. No determination of date or topic has been set.
- ! CST board strongly encourages all riders to wear helmets. They are available for purchase in the concessions tent for \$20.00 (a \$70.00 value). 8:28 Meeting Adjourned
