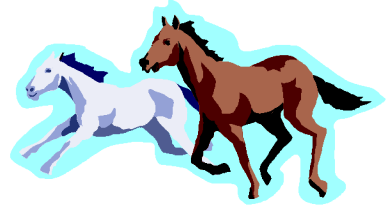
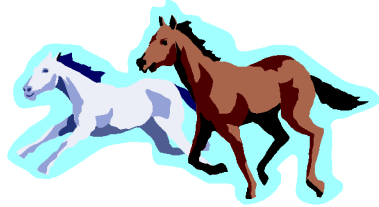
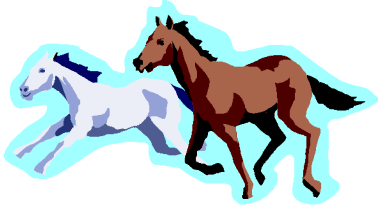
Royalty Report

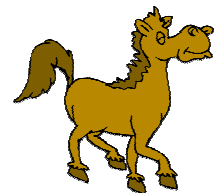
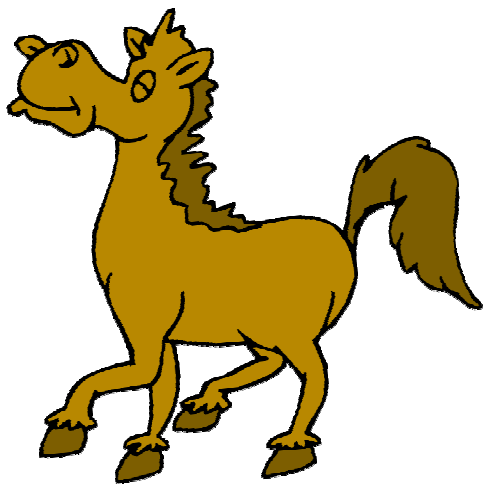

Cheyenne Saddle Tramps Meeting Minutes- July 19, 2006

Meeting Called to Order at 7:03pm

Minutes from June meeting approved pending typing of minutes

President: Brett- Motion made to for go the reports from each board member to have time for pending issue on Club House Rental

First Issue: Cecilia Goings/Becky Bowman wanted to discuss getting back their deposit from CST for club rental. They stated that the clubhouse wasn't acceptable for the wedding reception they booked it for. They stated that it wasn't in the condition it was in when they looked at in October. Ms. Goings took pictures of the club before it had been cleaned from a previous party. Cecilia Goings stated that she received the key to the clubhouse by an employee of Lori Fura-White and didn't receive a call back from Lori stating that the clubhouse had been cleaned up. Lori states that she told Ms. Goings that the clubhouse wasn't ready until after Tuesday but would be ready for their reception. Cecilia and Becky chose not to use the clubhouse. Brett made the decision to further discuss the issue with the club members and get back to them regarding their deposit.

Second Issue: Renting of the club house to local bands for parties. Loud Noise and the negative publicity on News Channel 5. CST members, Neighbors surrounding the clubhouse and band members present at the meeting. Individuals were allowed to stand up and say what they wanted.

Heidi Kindsvater-CST member: States the cigarette butts around the front door are awful and she is donating Paint buckets to place on the sides of the door with either sand or kitty litter in them.

Vicky Johnson- Parent of Band member: Daughter and Son involved in GJ & Run Productions. She stated she would like to challenge the issue of underage drinking and doing drugs while the concerts are going on. She states that she herself and 4 other sets of parents were at the last show and most of the other shows and the issues brought up by the media are unfounded. She would request that the CST continue to rent to the kids and keep them in Wyoming. She would also request diversity.

Dominic Syracuse- Band Member: Request that CST continues to rent to the bands. Would like to see it for the youth of Cheyenne. Offered to come and clean up the grounds and pick up trash or whatever for a venue discount. Denies the drugs and alcohol abuse at the club.

Jan & Pete Wijek-Neighbor: States that kids are sitting out by their backyard passing drugs around then hiding in the bushes. She states that it is the responsibility of the CST to make sure that this is not happening and that the kids stay away from her property. She also states that the noise is out of control. When asked if police was called she stated that they don't even get out their police car and see if anything is going on. She suggests getting a rent a cop paid for by the CST.

Victoria Hall-CST member: States that the club needs to set boundaries. Concerned about the time frame that allows the band members and Cheyenne youth to be out after curfew. Also states that is very sad to see the reputation of the club being ruined and that the club needs to take responsibility. Wants something that is fair for all rentals and legal coverage for all. Wants it fixed tonight.

Mike Young- Cheyenne Youth: Comes to see shows. Needs the music. Over 90% Sober with 2% of other kids going in fields or coming out to shows already drinking. States that this is very small majority. States that the sheriff was out at least 6 times during the last show and didn't see anything going on. Request CST continue to rent clubhouse for shows.

Dr. Green-Neighbor: Lives on other side of barbwire to the south. #1 wants the weeds mowed down because of fire hazard. Stated that if a cigarette was lit his house would go up in flames. Suggested renting a tractor or bush hog to do the job. #2 stated that the shows were far out and he liked the idea of the kids being able to party down and thinks the neighbors should get in free. #3 Just would like to request that the bands have a reasonable time curfew especially on the weekdays.

Stephanie Skutt-CST Board Member: Wants everyone to understand what the club stands for and who it belongs to. The idea of the club is for CST and their horses and for the kids. Guest renting club house should be limited to where they go on the grounds. Should self police, not attacking the kids but should not rent the clubhouse for these shows. Also wants to find out the liability to the board and the club.

Cindy Loofsboro-CST member: Understands the homeowner's complaints. Wants time limit during weeks and curfew on weekends. Also doesn't want to rent to the kids. States kids shouldn't be out partying till midnight.

Jillian- Book Shows: Don't spend \$160.00 to trash places around town. Has no drinking, no smoking policy. Feels not responsible for what happens in the parking lot. Had the police at the clubhouse last show x1 and nothing reported? Has had these shows booked since last year.

Chris Chavez/Kyle Wilbur-Cheyenne Youth: Coming to shows since they were 13 years old. Have been to different concerts, wedding receptions, & graduation parties: questions responsibility of the board and the CST members. Wants to know why all of sudden these shows have become a problem. Stated had a show in the spring before Saddle Tramps owned the property with 300 kids outside on the lawn and a full PA system and no one complained. Wants the neighbors to answer why now?

Kyle Hartensen-Show goer: Wants the CST to continue to rent for the shows. Has seen cops at the shows. States that it is stupid kids that do the stupid things. Resolution maybe build fence and have policy enforced for wandering.

Susan Benning-CST member: Wants something resolved. Very upset about things going on. Wants the club to work at if the money is worth it or not? Stated that it is CST land and CST Club and we need to take control and fix the problem. Wants not to rent to anyone except be used by the club. Put a curfew in place and place rules where that means everyone is gone by the time of the curfew (not stop playing by the time) Doesn't want to rent to the bands anymore.

Phil Mitotes- Musician: States that he plays and listens to bands at the CST property. Expresses that it is an avenue for these kids to keep them off drugs. Says that people are stereotyping because of the clothes that they wear. People are assuming kids are on drugs and drinking instead of just having a good time.

William Laverne- Homeowner: Wants to answer the question about why so many complaints after the years of the club house being rented. He states that the loud music is becoming more frequent. Instead of being 3-4 times a summer, it is 3-4 times a week. He states that the homeowners are upset and that the phone calls will continue, cops being called will continue and the CST name will continue to be dragged through the mud.

Brett- President/CST: Said that he received phone calls and traveled to the CST grounds and was standing and checking things out when he received more phone calls complaining and he was at the grounds. He also stated that the complaint he got the other night was from a baptism not a concert.

Steph Skutt-CST Board Member: Says enough of this, these kids are asking for a place to go. Address the issue, work together and come to a resolution. Put a curfew into place and some restraints on the people who are renting and horse people and kid rock together. She also wants to know the liability of the club.

Matt Simpson-Homeowner/Neighbor: States that he has called frequently. States that the noise gets bad. He is upset about the frequency of the bands and the time that they play. He stated that he has no quality of life and can't even plan a BBQ in his backyard or family events. States that the noise level depends on the night. Has called the Sheriff's office but they never do anything about it. Wants the CST club to take responsibility. Also states that he called at 11:30 and could hear Brett's wife in the background shouting and wanting to know if he knew what time it was. His point he was trying to make, if they thought it was late, and then what would the neighbors think. He also stated that he heard Brett's wife say she wouldn't allow her daughter to go to concert.

Dominique Saracuse-Cheyenne Teenager: Wants to know that the teens mean no disrespect. Saying that he understands how the CST members must feel because Cheyenne teens are always in the media and being constantly in the mud for things that aren't true. He stated that there is really no other place that these teens can go and wants the CST to continue to rent to the bands.

Jillian-Books Shows: Had quick question for homeowners- Why go to the media instead of coming and talking to the people in charge of the shows and asking to turn the music down.

Victoria Hall- CST Member: Wants resolutions tonight. Don't want to wait and asks that everyone start thinking of resolutions.

Kathy Daily-Homeowner/Neighbor: Very Frustrated. She says that she is the one who called the media. She states that she doesn't want the Saddle Tramps to be known as bad or have a bad reputation-she just wants the parties to stop. She has called the police many times and feels that she is getting no answer. She wants the club to take responsibility. States she is tired of kids vomiting and urinating on her fence line. She did also state she was once a member of the saddle tramps and would be willing to volunteer her time to help with Gymkhana or Horse show.

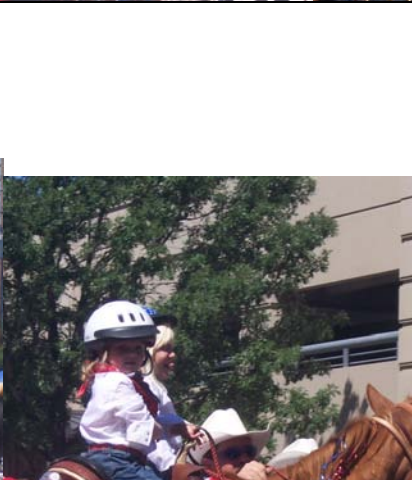
Susan Benning-CST Member: Poses the question to the board about liability. States that their is a law about socialization and drinking. Wants to know what the insurance covers and whether the board is responsible for the club house property. Wants resolution now.

Vicky Jones-Parent: Appreciate the time the board and club members have spent on this issue. Agrees that CST should not be cut down. States that Channel 5 News should take some responsibility. Sounds like there is a lot of potential to compromise. Thanks for listening

Lori Fura-White-CST Board Member: Does understand the neighbors concerns. Has made effort since things have come up to get extra parents for the concerts. Did go by 10:15 and everything was shut down & off property- Did clean the garbage. Is trying to get people to take more responsibility.

Brett-President: Has been brought to his attention that the club needs to vote on the resolutions. Will set up a club meeting but not until after Frontier Days to discuss with the members what they think should happen with the club house rentals. Thanked everyone of the homeowners, band members, and guest for coming to the meeting.
