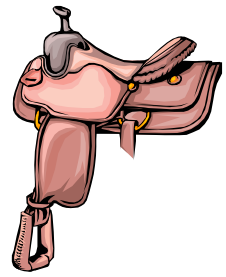

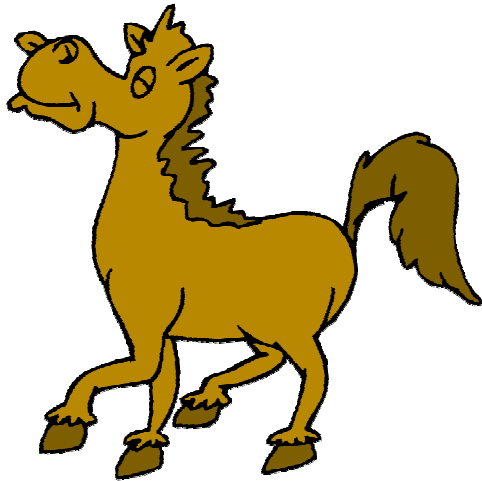

Our **DRILL TEAM** had their first performance of the year, Sunday May 21st at our CST gymkhana. Everyone had a great time and looked great too.

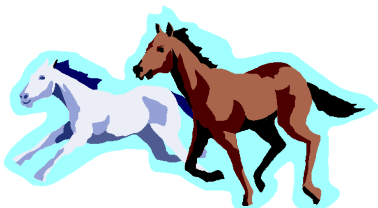
