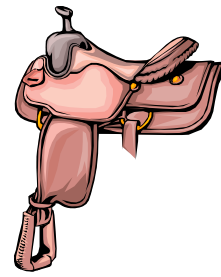

Royalty Report

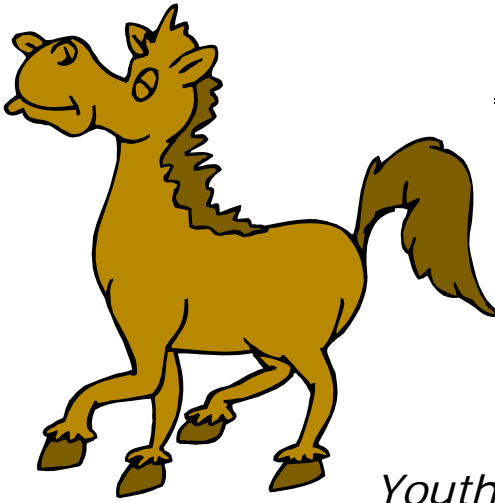

Meeting Minutes for Cheyenne Saddle Tramps

March 21, 2007 at 7:05pm

Minutes approved from last meeting

President: Stephanie Skutt- Discussed the Resignation of Brett McCurdy, Julie McCurdy and Becca McCurdy: Cruelty of animals to be discussed by Advisor

Incident of stolen money and police report available for discussion by members of club

Discussed options of payment plan of money for repayment or asking for lump sum or money to be repaid to the club. Locks have been changed and each board member has signed for copy of the key, Post office keys changed and President and Secretary have copies signed for. State of the club: move forward and get past this situation, look at the positive and work together as a club. Stephanie Skutt to follow up and ask for missing documents from the McCurdy's and get back any stuff belonging to Royalty. Stephanie Skutt is the point of contact as the president to the McCurdy's. Motion made and second for board to be able to carry forward the total due to the McCurdy's and submit a bill and then decide if payment not made to go to small claims court. Royalty position open: Nomination made by Stephanie Skutt to allow Kati Helfrich and future Special Olympic Riders be eligible for Queen. Kati to represent the club as Royalty Queen of the remainder of the term.

Vice President: Position now open because of Stephanie Skutt becoming president: Motion made and Second for Diane Stoddard to fill the position. Diane Stoddard voted as Vice President by club.

Secretary: Anita LaFond: Encourage the club members to let me know if they have any events needed to be put in the newsletter. Memberships coming in. Secretary now holds the key inventory for keys to clubhouse, post office box, and any equipment needed in the future.

Treasurer: Susan Benning: Financial Statement given to club. Balance in checkbook \$2365.30. Cheyenne Light Bill due of \$674.77. Also discussed that during a rental there was damage done to the men's bathroom. A police report and court order require the juvenile to pay club restitution of \$300.00 by June 1st. Treasurer request a calendar of the clubhouse rentals be brought to each of the monthly meetings. Audit of books up to date. No previous books available to audit. Motion made by Jay Ostby to allow an independent CPA to audit the CST books. Club decided that at this time, Treasurer and Advisor can be responsible for this at this time.

Horseshow/Gymkhana/3-D Barrels: Jody Osban: Dates of Events for 2007 voted on and accepted by the club. Jody requested that since she is going to show at the events that another individual take responsibility for hiring of the judges since this could be deemed a conflict of interest. Joey Corder volunteered and is the Co-Chair of these events. Question brought up by a club member about 3-D Barrel series to be run this spring. Jody discussed this and states we need to make sure the ground is okay and that we have lights in the arena. Follow up needed to find out if City would be willing to move the old lights from the Converse area. CST does have some light poles but need to be put in the ground. Jay Ostby stated that the wiring would need to be updated to the arena.

Grounds: Stephanie Skutt: Discussed the arena and updates that need to be made. Several members had ideas. Discussed with the club to put their ideas and goals in writing and bring it to the next meeting. Disc and Rock Picker available for purchase through Steph Skutt club needs to make the decision on buying each.

Royalty Advisor: Cindy Loofboro: Motion made and Second to make Kati Helfrich the 2007 Queen. Cindy to get a list of things missing from Becca McCurdy and a price by the fair market value to the President of the club as soon as possible to be added to the bill. Would like the Royalty to wear the club colors of Red, Black and White.

Building Coordinator: Cindy Loofboro (Interim) Position is official open. Has blinds available that she is going to have put up by Kelly. Will get the calendar of rentals together. Gary Pitts made donation of updating the clubhouse floor. The cost of the materials to be provided by the club. Motion made and second for the club to keep the renter's total deposit for cleaning fees and hire someone to come in and clean clubhouse

Advisor: Lisa Pontoriero: Discussed the Royalty resignation from the incident of cruelty of animals. Have Vet statement that states the condition of the horse was from malnutrition. Current audit done for this year.

Rules: Lisa Pontoriero: Rules and Constitution changes suggested by the rules committee read to the club. These rules and constitution will be voted on at next meeting

Concessions: Open Position: Cindy Loofboro states that her mother n law will do the provide concessions as a personal fund raiser.

Parades: Position Open: Suggested that Margie Earlywine would like to assist with this position- needs to come to the next meeting to be present to be nominated for this position. Heidi Kindsvater has the application for Frontier Days and will send it in for CST. Would like for the CST to accept 4-H parade clinic and offer some dates of them together.

Drill Team: Open Position: Motion made and second for Diane Stoddard to become the drill chair. She accepted this position.

Website: Jay Ostby: Did get a picture of John Easterwood on the website. Would like to create permanent history of the club. Open to adding or changing the website to be more user friendly.

Royalty Report: Randi Rae very happy to accept Kati Helfrich as her Queen. Both are ready to get started and have fun during their reign as Princess and Queen.

New Business: * Motion made by Dan Pontoriero to change the clubs name to Cheyenne Saddle Club-states that his problem is the reputation of the club-feels changing the name will help with the future of the club- Dan to look into the legal aspects of this. *Motion made and second for CST to donate two memberships to TacoBingo Night of the elementary school in burns. This is a fundraiser for their school.*Lisa Pontoriero states that the Willadensen Elementary School would love to have some help during their work days that would count as community service hours.

*Cindy Braden from Frontier Days Junior Barrels would like the club to know that signup for the Junior Barrels is April 2nd. This is for 12 and under and a Laramie County Resident. Motion made and second for use of the CST eye for the Junior Barrels.

*Susan Benning request that 4-H be able to use the saddle tramps arena for level testing. May 12th and June 2nd are proposed dates. Motion made and second as long as these dates don't interrupt the CST events or members using the arena

Old Business: APHA is going to approve PAC Points for the CST events. Paint Horse events will be done at the CST shows and gymkhana. Dates given to the APHA.
