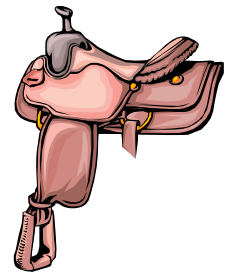

Arena Etiquette and Safety

Etiquette:

1. Left Shoulder to Left Shoulder. Riders should try and ride in the same direction.
2. Slow on the inside, Fast on the outside
3. Announce your intentions: Tell the other riders what you plan to do (exception is when showing)
4. No Lunging while riding
5. Mount out of the way
6. Work Together: Users should be doing similar things, if at all possible. Be generous with right of way
7. Cue Quietly: Voice commands, kissing, smooching to cue your horse should be done quietly and away from other horses. Accidentally cueing another person's horse as you ride along side of them can cause problems
8. Clean UP: Clean up the arena after use. Clear out manure, put away jumps, poles, pylons. Leave it the way you found it or better.
9. Try not to interrupt lessons.
10. Follow posted rules.

Safety:

1. Keep a horse length between: Don't crowd other riders and keep at least a horse length between you and horse in front or beside you. Keeps you at a safe distance from being kicked or your horse bitten
2. No Smoking with in the arena; can be a fire hazard
3. All Horses under control: There should be no loose horses
4. In case of emergency: know where the closest phone is and the first aid kit is located
5. Don't allow escapes: keep all doors or gates closed.
6. Be aware: If another rider is having trouble with a horse, is riding a young horse, or is a beginner or timid rider.
7. Give Right of Way: Be generous of the right of way even if it is technically not the correct way.
8. Don't ride alone: (especially if jumping)
9. Don't get caught in the dark: Be aware in stormy weather
10. Always ride safe: Wear a helmet and proper boots and ride in control
11. Keep the Dogs on a Leash
12. In an Emergency get off.
13. Adhere to CST Rules

Minutes from April Meeting Approved/Second

Horse Show: Connie Riesland: Not Present- No Report

Gymkhana: Jody Clark: Had \$800.00 in entry fees. Wants to add new events. Motion made and Second for Stock fee of \$1.00 to be added for Goat Tying for Jody Clark's expense of cost of goats and feeding them. Some confusion of order of events and Age divisions but overall gymkhana went well. Age divisions are by the CST Rules and not AQHA. Jody Clark did say she would resign her position as chair if voted on time change.

3-D Barrels: Jody Osban: No Report

Grounds: Tammy Maas: Had 3 work sessions that accomplished: Gates for new trail area, panels around crows nest placed to keep horses away, Painted Plywood on Crow's Nest, Vacuumed the glass around the Crow's Nest, Latch on Crow's Nest with Lock, Placed panels in front of tractor, Drilled post holes for fence around trail, Trash Pickup. Things to do: Fix wooden stalls, Broken rails in and around the arena, Gate on Round pen, Tune-up Tractor, Pull out the rail road ties. Disc the new trail area and the warm-up arena. Received three estimates for the lights and electricity. Quotes are as follows: \$25,400, \$23,750, and lowest of \$18,558.00 (which is a member of the club and gave discount on labor cost). These estimates would include the cost of the new electricity, light poles and putting in future lines for the new Crow's Nest. Motion made and second for Tammy Maas to get an estimate for just the cost of getting new service to the arena and crow's nest. She has made contact with the City of Cheyenne to find out about grants that are available. She will contact CLFP and see if they are willing to donate any time or materials for the lights. She has worked on mounting the signs for the sponsors of the Royalty. Marjorie Earlywine and the Mable Strickland Cowgirl Museum wants to buy advertising in sign for the arena. Several members brought up the idea of advertising and getting donations for the lights. Advisor Lisa Pontoriero did bring up the fact that we have a fundraiser/sponsorship position available for anyone that wants to volunteer.

Advisor/Rules: Lisa Pontoriero: Addressing the WPHC at board meeting and will get clarification for next meeting, Addressed computer program for Points at Horse show and Gymkhana, Clarified age divisions, Would like it to be addressed at the Horse Shows and Gymkhana's to follow safety rules. No Double Riding, Walking except in arena or warm up area, Keep Gate area clear, Watch for little pedestrians, maybe making announcements throughout the day.

Building: Cindy Loofboro: Clubhouse continues to have rentals. Discussed the last person who rented the club. Broken glass beer bottles by front door. Motion made and Second for Margie Earlywine and Cindy to update the checklist and contract for rentals to be more specific. Also for deposit not to be given back immediately or until the clubhouse is cleaned including outside. Explained to Cindy that it is the responsibility of the person renting the clubhouse to clean up after not the chair person's.

Drill: Motion made and second with Barb accepting nomination of Drill Chair. Wants to have walked though of drill before riding. Date set for first walk through of May 26, 2008 At 6:00pm at CST Clubhouse. Possible changing the riding of the drill team from the traditional before the Gymkhana to the Horseshow so don't have to take the timer down and put back up. Decision tabled until next meeting.

Parades: Margie Earlywine: Mable Strickland Cowgirl Museum donated scarfs for the parades- red, white and blue and very patriotic. Had the Wyoming and American Flag cleaned. Anita has the other flags and will get with Margie to get them cleaned. Sheriff's Posse display at museum big success. Parade Clinic- 4-H/CST combined set for July 7th 5:00pm. Susan Benning to give Margie the application and proof of Insurance for parades.

Concessions: Elaine Anderson: After the Easter wood and 1st Gymkhana finally paid for the supplies and actually has about a \$10.00 profit.

Royalty Advisor: Cindy Loofboro: Dianna at Wrangler donated a pair of boots for the girls. Girls have been invited to attend the Wrangler's Fashion Show at the Old West Museum May 29th.

Royalty: 2008 Queen Lori Riesland, 2008 Princess Rylee Anderson: No Report not present

Old Business:

*Discussion of motion recall of the vote changing the time of the Gymkhana. New Member: Patty Guthrie brought up that she liked the early time change, Cindy Loofboro stated she wanted to know why the vote was even brought up again. Jody Clark stated that the line about the recall in the constitution was very vague and maybe needed to be addressed. Lisa Pontoriero, Advisor stated that the constitution and rules are read twice and voted on the changes for the year at the March and April meeting. Call to Vote: Gymkhana Time to remain 0900 Registration and 1000 Start: Vote Passed 12/7

Discussion about the rule: Can Register for event until 2 Divisions before the Start of the division registering for. Order of Events: Barrels, Flags,Poles, Keyhole with special Races to be run after that.

*Last year funds were appropriated for the fence mounts of the timer and cable for computer. Jody Osban to order these components to be here before the next Gymkhana.

*WPHC APHA Show will be August 16, 2008.
