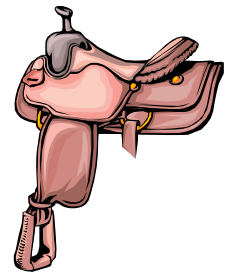

Cheyenne Saddle Tramps Meeting Minutes: April 16, 2008

Meeting called to order: 7:00pm

Minutes from previous meeting approved and second

President: Todd Miller: Not present for beginning of meeting, Anita had email from him and discussed the radio broadcast from KOLT FM. Motion to pay \$200 for 20 commercials and one of the Dj's to show up at the Easterwood but no broadcast for advertising- Motion Failed. Stage Coach deferred to Grounds.

Vice President: Jody Osban: Followed up on Hands N' Harmony- money to be donated after the Easterwood.

Secretary: Anita LaFond: Website updated for weather, link to updated directions, and link to riding club road added. If any further information contact me and we can add it. Also, link for me to get news, dates, events that are happening with club members to put in newsletter. Enough trophies for Easterwood and some others left over. Susan to try and get engraving done before Easterwood by Cheyenne Trophy and Engraving.

Treasurer: Susan Benning: Treasurer Report read to club. Paid property taxes last month. Check book balance \$795.85. Worked out Porta Potty contract with R&R. Will arrive for the Easterwood and remain until after last show. If additional service is needed additional cost of \$25.00 will be added to bill. Received a copy of the 4-H/CST Gymkhana Registration form and Rules and Guidelines. The date of the Gymkhana is set for June 6th.

Horse Show: Connie Riesland: Wanted to thank everyone for helping her out with this first show. Has been lining up judges and Easterwood judge is booked. Jody Osban working on advertising in the trader's for the Easterwood.

Gymkhana: Jody Clark: Not present due to illness in family. No Report

3-D Barrels: Jody Osban: Not having series because of no lights in the arena.

Grounds: Tammy Maas: Had first workday, last Saturday- Happy with what got accomplished. Picked up trash around the crows nest/arena. Cleaned out crows nest (thanks Rylee for all your help). Took off broken gate on round pen and Don Crearer to weld it and put it back on before Easterwood. Consolidated all CST Equipment and placed in Roping Box. Placed cone over railroad tie that was a safety issue and will remove it at next workday. Workday #2 set for April 25 at 1:00pm until whenever. Goal would be to pick up more trash, paint plywood on current crows nest, fix latch on crows nest door, remove the railroad tie to alleviate safety hazard. Configure the panels around the crows nest to be more constructive for the horseshow and posting patterns. Tammy brought a big display of the arena and discussed possible future plans. Motion made and second to keep the warm up arena the same area. Stalls on north side of arena in very bad shape. Motion made and second/Passed to take down the old stalls and utilize the wood to fix the stalls on the south side of the arena. Motion made and second/Passed to move the trail course to behind the round pen and place a gate. Discussed future plans that would like to see happen to the grounds- Will be placed in the newsletter. Lights- received an estimate for \$25,000.00. Unable to use the poles that we currently have for lights. Need new service w/meter box. Suggested by Lisa that CLFP and Great West be notified to ask about used wood poles to be purchased. Grounds will be worked before the Easterwood. Calendar developed to keep track of dates booked for the arena. CST Events and membership have priority.

Advisor/Rules: Lisa Pontoriero Proposed 2008 changes to the constitution and rules read and voted on. All proposed changes passed. 2008 Rules and Constitution will be sent to Jay to be placed on the website and a copy be printed out to be available at the shows/gymkhana's. If new members would like a copy can be referred to the website and if no computer access can be given a copy by secretary.

Building: Cindy Loofboro: Discussed rental agreement with chair. Clubhouse rental agreement to be placed on the internet. Every person renting clubhouse must sign rental agreement.

Drill: Diane Stoddard: Has received and passed on parade application for Drill Team to Margie Earlywine. As soon as weather breaks will start schedule. Have several people interested and a group from Colorado that would like to ride with CST Drill Team. Request time at Gymkhana to perform. Will have STP as sponsor and hopefully perform during their day at CFD.

Parades: Margie Earlywine: parade clinic set for July 7th @ 5:00pm w/ 4-H at the CST Arena. Will set another clinic date closer to summer.

Concessions: Elaine Anderson: Not Present. Cindy Loofboro reported that Elaine is setting up trailer for the concessions. Pepsi of Cheyenne is donating the soda for the concessions.

Royalty Advisor: Cindy Loofboro: Things are starting to come in; there was a mix up with sizes of clothes by the Wrangler.

Royalty: 2008 Queen Lori Riesland, 2008 Princess Rylee Anderson, received new hat from Charlie Horse Hat Company that has stars stamped out around the rim. These hats aren't in stores yet. New line. Both girls have decided to have a stars theme this year.

Old Business:

Received motion from Vice President to Recall the motion from last month's meeting regarding the time change of the gymkhana. According to CST Constitution (pg 8) a motion can be recalled by 2/3 majority vote of membership at meeting. Motion for time change of Gymkhana recalled. After member discussion motion was made to keep the time change of 0900 Registration with 1000 Start for the First Gymkhana since membership meeting for May after gymkhana date. Gymkhana chair not present due to family illness and not able to discuss time change. Motion second/Passed. Agreed by membership to place a note in the newsletter and on website about time change and it will be voted on at the next membership meeting.

WPHC- Show Date for August confirmed. Will get own insurance for the arena usage. Next meeting scheduled for 1PM on Sunday, April 20, 2008 at Public Library.

Cindy Loofboro requested that Kelly pay for stove to be inspected- last month motion made and passed to have CLFP come out and cap the line. President to look into this. Cindy concern about how much the stove is worth if in working order. Motion made/Second & passed for Tammy Maas to take the stove to Western Auction and if any money to be put in CST fund.

New Business:

Motion made/Second Passed to allow the funds for new trail bridge to be built. Rob Benning will donate time to build it but reimbursed the materials.

Motion made/Second & Passed for Fee Schedule as follows: Stall Rental \$10.00 Day/Horse, Water Usage \$5.00 fee except increase for camper and bigger tanks- That price tabled until quotes from other sources. If non member want to use arena- \$5.00 hr and must sign waiver. Arena usage fee per day \$100 and \$100 deposit and must have own insurance. Tabled the parking fee.

Received card and possible sponsorship by Gordon Sign- New Member's husband and he makes signs. Is willing to donate the time and printing if CST pays for the vinyl.

Meeting Adjourned at 8:50 pm.

Horse Trivia

" Trigger" originally named "Golden Cloud" appeared in "Adventures of Robin Hood" ridden by Olivia De Havilland, before being acquired by Roy. The palomino stallion was ridden for Roy Roger's first starring role in Under the Western Stars (1939).

When the studio boss threatened to take "Trigger " away. Roy told him sorry but he'd already bought the horse for \$2,500. Trigger, appeared in all of Roy's movies and TV series. He died in 1965, lived to ripe old horse age of 33.
