Meeting called to order: 7:06 PM PM by President Jody Osban

Minutes approved from last meeting.



**President:** Jody Osban. No report.

**Vice President:** Anita LaFond. Not present.

**Secretary:** Heidi King. Still working on putting membership information in Access Database. Can now print out list of people who indicated they would volunteer on membership application to that chairperson. Please send items for the Newsletter!

**Treasurer:** Open. We have a new Treasurer! Bob Fecht has stepped up to serve in this important role. He wasn't able to be present at the meeting, but submitted a letter of acceptance. Todd made a motion to approve Bob as the 2010 Treasurer. The motion was seconded, a vote was taken, and it was unanimously approved. Welcome Bob! Susan Benning, the outgoing Treasurer, submitted the Treasurer's report, which was unanimously approved. Checking account balance is \$2519.64. Susan has filed our 2009 tax return and paid the second half of the property taxes. There is still a \$600.00 check outstanding from WPHC. Thanks to Susan for all her hard work over the last few years as our treasurer!

**Horse Show:** Victoria Hall. Not present.

**Gymkhana:** Todd Miller. Gymkhana dates are set. There won't be goats this year prior to the gymkhanas.

**Concessions:** Chris Haas, Cat Brown. Not present.

**Grounds:** Tammy Maas. First work day of year is April 11<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM. Come out and help get the grounds looking great for our first show! Remember, to be eligible for year-end awards, volunteer time is mandatory. Helping on work days is a great way to earn your volunteer time. Tammy has signed up for a grants writing class on April 24<sup>th</sup>. We already have one reservation for CFD! The Merrill's have volunteered to work the arena in preparation of the Easterwood show on April 24<sup>th</sup>. This will be a great way to start off the year! Tammy will be moving some materials and supplies from Jay's house to the clubhouse. The Williams and Roylance families have volunteered to paint all fences, etc., so Tammy will be buying, or hopefully, getting paint donated to us. Thanks to the Williams and Roylances! We will spray early and often for weeds around the arena. This worked really well last year. She would like to purchase, or have donated, new barrels.

**3-D Barrels:** Jody Osban. Still working on dates. Considering having them on the morning of Gymkhanas. This would be 6 dates. Otherwise, may have to have on holiday weekends: Fourth of July, Father's Day, Labor Day, etc.

**Rules:** Wendy Miller. The Rules Committee met March 12<sup>th</sup> and are proposing the following changes. Constitution, Article 6, Duties and Responsibilities, Section 2. Propose moving "And is responsible for collection and validating all volunteer records from the appropriate Chairperson, and then passing them on to the Secretary" from the Vice-President (2) to the Secretary (3). Constitution By-Laws, Article 9, Parades and Grand Entries, propose changing "This consists of a white long sleeved shirt, white toned straw hat, red neck scarf, black denim pants and cowboy boots." to "This consists of a white long sleeved shirt, white toned straw hat, blue denim pants, and cowboy boots. Neck scarfs will be provided by the Parade Chairperson. Red saddle pads are to be worn on Saturday and Tuesday parades, and black saddle pads are to worn on Thursday Parades ." A vote will be taken at the April Membership Meeting to approve these changes.
