### **July 21, 2010 CST Arena 7:00pm**

Meeting called to order: 7:00 PM by President Jody Osban

Minutes approved from last meeting.

**President:** Jody Osban. No report.

**Vice President:** Anita LaFond. Not Present.

**Secretary:** Heidi King. Will be removing non-paid members from mailing list by end of month. Keep sending in Volunteer Hour Tracking forms. Will be placing a nomination form, per our Rules, in the August Newsletter for the Vossler, Easterwood, Lifetime, and Most Improved Rider awards. The nomination forms are due back to her by the September 15th Membership Meeting.

**Treasurer:** Robert Fecht. Checkbook balance is \$9,302.08. We also have \$6085.66 on deposit in CD's.

**Horse Show:** Victoria Hall. One more left! Made up the rained out portion of the 4th show at July 10th show so we are all caught up. Will be ordering year-end awards after Frontier Days.

**Gymkhana:** Todd Miller. Rained out again at the July 11th gymkhana. Did get through flags, so have poles and key-hole to make up. Will make up this and the remainder of the June 6th gymkhana on the rain date. Only those who were already signed up for these gymkhana's will be allowed to participate. If there is time, may have a jackpot barrel race before or after the make-up events are run.

**Concessions:** Chris Haas, Cat Brown. Not Present.

**Grounds:** Tammy Maas. Not Present, but sent report. The stalls are all rented for CFD and we have a potential profit of \$1600.00! The next work night is August 5th from 6-8 PM.

**Advisor:** Wendy Miller. Have gymkhana audited, needs to do Horse Show.

**3-D Barrels:** Jody Osban. Series will start August 13th and will run for 6 consecutive weeks. Entries will be \$20.00 and \$5.00 for exhibition runs. Three age groups: 18 & under, 19 & over, and Open. She will be running an ad in Traders after Frontier Days.

**Building:** Open.

**Royalty Advisor:** Victoria Hall. No Report

**Royalty:** 2010 Queen Gracie Brown. 2010 Princess Jordan Rudolph. The girls are excited that Frontier Days is finally here and are looking forward to representing CST!

**Parades:** Heidi King. Ended up having 4 parades clinics and had 55 horse/riders combinations attend. Have as many as 32 signed up for the parades, 17 for grand entries. She had the flags cleaned, painted the poles and ordered new caps for the WY and CST flags. She purchased 25 red and 5 black scarfs. A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved to reimburse Heidi \$164.95 for the scarfs. She is requiring they be returned after each parade/grand entry so she has enough for the week and so they can be used again in years to come.

**Clinician:** Open.

**Drill:** Victoria Hall. They are ready to go! Been practicing at CST and Frontier Park. They will perform at the CFD pre-rodeo performance on Saturday, July 24th.

**New Business:** Victoria stated that 4H was going to have a benefit gymkhana in September for Tate Carnahan, a 4H'er who was injured at the county fair and sent on Flight for Life to Denver. He is recovering, but has enormous medical expenses. 4H would like CST to be a co-sponsor at the benefit show. A motion was made, second, and unanimously approved to be a co-sponsor at the benefit show. It will be held at LCCC, but a date hasn't been set yet. Jody brought up an idea for next year. The club could purchase some calves in the spring, let them graze the pastures on the CST grounds, use the calves to have some team penning and ranch sorting events during the summer, then sell them in the fall. Will be brought up again in future meetings, if anyone has any input.
