If you plan to ride in a CFD Parade or Grand Entry, you **MUST** attend a parade clinic with the horse you will be riding. Be sure to check in with Heidi King, Parade Chair, at the clinic so you receive credit for attending. The official CST parade costume is blue jeans, white long-sleeved shirt, white-toned straw hat (or helmet), and cowboy boots. Neck scarves will be provided to you at the parade/grand entry. You will need a red saddle pad for the Saturday and Tuesday parades/grand entries and a black saddle pad for the Thursday parade/grand entry.

Meeting called to order: 7:05 PM by President Jody Osban  
Minutes approved from last meeting.

**President:** Jody Osban. Deposit made for \$4903.75. This is for two horse shows, 2 gymkhanas, concessions, and the fun day. The saddle for the All Around Horse award is done and was brought to the meeting.

**Vice President:** Anita LaFond. WPHC is re-issuing a \$600.00 outstanding check to CST. They will be reimbursing CST \$75.00 for each 2010 horse show for Judging costs.

**Secretary:** Heidi King. Working on contacting all members who have not paid 2010 dues to remind them. There aren't many. Also working on a key inventory. Crow's nest key issued to Vice President Anita LaFond after the meeting. Tracking volunteer hours. Remember to complete the Volunteer Hour Tracking Form for any hours you volunteer and turn it into Heidi no later than 09/30/10.

**Treasurer:** Robert Fecht. Checkbook balance is \$4986.61 before deposit made by President Jody Osban listed above.

**Horse Show:** Victoria Hall. The new ribbons are here. Cost was \$1000.00 which will be enough supply for the rest of the year. Horse show profit is averaging \$700 - \$800 per show. She has an Assistant Horse Show Chair, Lynae Kunz. All judges have been scheduled for the rest of the year.

**Gymkhana:** Todd Miller. Had to cancel just over 1/2 of the last gymkhana due to thunderstorms in the area. Got through Junior Flags. All placings will stand, and will make up the rest, starting with PeeWee flags, on first rain date, September 12<sup>th</sup>. Gymkhana profit is averaging \$1500 per gymkhana.

**Concessions:** Chris Haas, Cat Brown. Concessions has been doing well! \$160.00 on 06/27; \$62 on 05/31 (Fun Day) and \$216 on 06/05. This money goes into the Royalty fund to support the girls' activities and wardrobes each year.

**Grounds:** Tammy Maas. Not Present. The Williamson and Roylance families painted all the white fencing and it looks fantastic! Next work day is June 24<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM. Bring mowers, weed eaters, fencing materials, and gloves. There's a lot to do to get ready for Fronter Days stall rentals, so please come on out and pitch in. Any time you spend counts towards volunteer hours.

**Advisor:** Wendy Miller. Getting ready to audit the gymkhana and horse show books.

**3-D Barrels:** Jody Osban. Will start August 13<sup>th</sup> and run for six consecutive weeks, including Labor Day weekend. Registration will be at 6:00 and will start running barrels at 6:30. Cost is \$20, and \$5 for exhibition runs.

**Building:** Open.

**Royalty Advisor:** Victoria Hall. The CFD Coronation Ball is July 17<sup>th</sup>. Todd Miller has tickets and may get a table reserved for CST Royalty and members. Contact him if you would like tickets. Will be preparing the Royalty Packets for the upcoming tryouts.

**Royalty:** 2010 Queen Gracie Brown. 2010 Princess Jordan Rudolph. Gracie and Jordan participated in the CFD Fashion Show which was a benefit for the Crisis Fund. They got to keep the outfits they modeled. They even got to ride stick horses! The girls were fantastic representatives of CST. They received their black boots. Will have pictures taken in July. They are looking forward to the CFD Coronation Ball and all the CFD activities.

**Parades:** Heidi King. Three parade clinics are scheduled: 06/20 at LCCC, 07/09 at Archer, and 07/18 at CST. Created a guideline and acknowledgement form to give participants at the clinics which has costume list and rules. Ordered 30 scarves to use for parades/grand entries, 25 red and 5 black for outriders.
