Must show in a minimum of 50% of english classes (12 classes), 50% of western classes (15 classes) and 50% of gymkhana classes (12 classes). However, all points count, if you show in more than the minimum classes required. No substitutions are allowed for either horse or rider. Must be a CST member and have completed the CST Volunteer Hours requirements to be eligible.

Meeting called to order: 7:02 PM by President Jody Osban

Minutes approved from last meeting.

President: Jody Osban. No report.

Vice President: Anita LaFond. Not present.

Secretary: Heidi King. Keep sending newsletter items. In the process of doing key inventory. Drafted guidelines for the volunteer hours, the board has reviewed and approved. Will get the guidelines posted on the website.

Treasurer: Robert Fecht. Not present.

Horse Show: Victoria Hall. All ready for the Easterwood show, and hopes the weather cooperates. There will be some new judges this year that have come highly recommended. The horse show entry forms are on the website. Please complete the form and bring it with you to the show - this will save time at registration. Jody put a great ad in Traders with all the 2010 horse show and gymkhana dates. It will run two times, then will just run with the upcoming dates. Ribbon inventory is done and there are enough for the first show and gymkhana. In case of cancellation of horse shows/gymkhanas, tune to 95.1, 100.7 or 106.3 FM or check the CST website or Facebook.

Gymkhana: Todd Miller. The gymkhana entry forms are on the website. Please complete the form and bring it with you to the gymkhana - this will save time at registration. Will try a new keyhole pattern at the Easterwood show. It is easier to set up and takes less people monitoring it and resetting it. If it's successful, will try it at regular gymkhanas.

Concessions: Chris Haas, Cat Brown. Waiting to hear back from Coke to use the trailer this year. Working to get donations to stock concession stand. They'll be ready for the Easterwood show.

Grounds: Tammy Maas. Tammy introduced two new members of the grounds committee, Helen Roylance and Kathy Gilmartin. The Roylance and Williamson families will be painting all the fence, etc., at the arena as soon as weather permits. Home Depot donated 10 gallons of white paint. Dooley Oil donated three new barrels and Tammy will get them painted before the first gymkhana. The jumping poles have been repainted. Tammy requested to be reimbursed for half the cost of taking a grants-writing class at LCCC. A motion was made, seconded and it was unanimously approved to reimburse Tammy. The class will be April 24th, the same day as the Easterwood show. The work day on April 11th was great - 16 people were there! Several cleaning tasks were completed, painting, fencing, and spraying for weeds. We already have four reservations for Frontier Days. Merrill, Inc., will come and work the arena, the porta-potties will be delivered and the dumpster will be emptied prior to the Easterwood show. We have tentatively booked the Shrine club for our annual banquet for November 13th.

Advisor: Wendy Miller. No report.

3-D Barrels: Jody Osban. Tentatively set to begin 3-D Barrels either Friday August 13th or the 20th and run for 6 weeks. This will include Labor Day weekend.
