October 20, 2010 LCCC AG Room 118 7:00pm

Meeting called to order: 7:01 PM by Victoria Hall

Minutes approved from last meeting.

President: Jody Osban. Not Present.

Vice President: Anita LaFond. Not Present.

Secretary: Heidi King. Has collected and tabulated volunteer hours and sent them to Todd and Victoria so they can determine high point award winners and order awards.

Treasurer: Robert Fecht. Checking account balance \$8145.33. Year-end awards have been ordered (approximately \$7000). Auditing financial reports back to January.

Horse Show: Victoria Hall. Awards have been ordered. Most stuff is in already. Took some stuff for embroidery. Everything is customized and club colors.

Gymkhana: Todd Miller. Ditto horse show. Set money aside for all-around saddle next year? Victoria will make motion at awards banquet to reserve money for next year. Match from 3-D barrels.

Concessions: Chris Haas, Cat Brown. Chris not present. Netted about \$900 after expenses and things bought to use for next year (crock pot, storage bins, etc.). Coke trailer still there. Concessions gift basket at the awards banquet and gift cards for next year.

Grounds: Tammy Maas. Not Present, but sent report. The board met Monday, October 18th, to review a draft grant application, mission statement, and master plan. Present at the meeting were Jody Osban, Victoria Hall, Bob Fecht, Todd Miller, Wendy Miller, and Tammy Maas. We discussed short term priorities (3-5 years) and long term priorities (5-15

years). Tammy will continue to work on the grant application and submit to potential donors as soon as possible. Our short term priorities are: new tractor, shed to store tractor and other equipment, PA system, lights, improvements to warm up arena.

Advisor: Wendy Miller. Got books audited, everything is in good shape.

3-D Barrels: Jody Osban. Not Present.

Building: Open.

Royalty Advisor: Victoria Hall. Royalty tryouts were October 10th. Fantastic judge, and she will be mentor for royalty in upcoming year. 1 Queen contestant and 2 Princesses tried out. Went well. Close contest. The constitution says the Royalty chair serves October to October, but the rules say from banquet to banquet. Needs to be changed next year.

Royalty: 2010 Queen Gracie Brown. 2010 Princess Jordan Rudolph. Gracie introduced our new 2011 Princess, Hally Jankovsky, Gracies's sister. The 2011 Queen is Jordan Rudolph, the current (2010) Princess.
