Minutes approved from last meeting.

Grounds: Tammy Maas. Has made initial preparations for show season. Merrill Inc., will rip the arena prior to the first show and again in June/July. They will also bring in additional sand. Approximate cost will be \$200.00. John Pippinger, a CST member, will mow the large parking area and grounds surrounding the arena prior to first show and additionally throughout the season as needed. Thank you John!! Got an estimate from Lee's Toy Box for annual tune up on the tractor which will be \$100 - \$150. Received a donation of arena lights, meeting with Simpson Electric this week to get an estimate to install. First work day is Sunday, April 10th from 1:00 - 3:00 PM. Primary goal will be to repair fences, pick up trash, spray for weeds, and mow if necessary. Passed out grant application to board members for their review and comments. Board members, please have comments back to Tammy within two weeks so she can send it out. Tended her resignation as Grounds Chairperson effective March 30th due to other commitments. Will continue to work on the long-range plans including septic system, crow's nest and grant applications. Anyone interested in taking Tammy's place as Grounds Chairperson, please contact a Board member. Thanks to Tammy for all of her hard work throughout the years!

Advisor: Michelle Martinez. Will be auditing books in June.

3-D Barrels: Amanda Kroul. Tentative dates for first three events are: May 7, June 18, and July 16. Registration will be at noon and racing starts at 1:00 PM. Barrel covers are printed with CST logo. Will work on getting sponsorships.

Old Business: Horse show/gymkhana dates: Easterwood, April 16th w/rain date 23rd. Point show/gymkhanas: April 30/May 1, May 14/15, June 11/12, June 25/26, July 9/10, August 27/28, rain dates September 10/11 and 17/18. Motion, second, and unanimous approval to accept horse show/gymkhana dates. Comments on proposed rules: new point system needs to be re-evaluated. Comments on proposed constitution: on page 8, should say "AQHA" rather than "Quarter Horse," and; on page 9, remove "unless the Board grants prior approval for an event." Motion, second, and unanimous approval to accept proposed constitution, with the changes noted above. Motion, second, and unanimous approval to accept proposed rules, except for the new point system. Discussion took place regarding the proposed new point system. A motion was made and seconded to accept the proposed new point system. A vote was taken, and less than 2/3 of the members present voted to approve, therefore, the motion was not passed and as a result, the previous point system will remain in effect. The 2011 Rules and Constitution will be emailed to the membership and posted on the website.

New Business: Junior Board met during regular membership meeting and gave a report. Elected officers. President: Ellie Pontoriero; Vice President: Jordan Burdick; Secretary: Kaitlyn Rinker; Treasurer: Tonie Prego. They would like to have fun games at the Easterwood show such as a pudding race, egg race, and dollar bill race. Would like to have a costume contest later in the year. They will look for donations for pudding and eggs for the Easterwood show and will look into fund raising ideas. Motion, second, and unanimous approval to allow the Junior Board to have fun classes at the Easterwood show. New members present were introduced.
