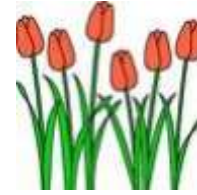
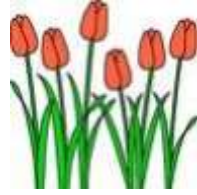

## CST/4H Reining/ Programmed Ride Clinic

The Windy Mountain Ranchers 4-H Club in partnership with Cheyenne Saddle Tramps has a riding clinic scheduled for Sunday, May 22nd at the LCCC indoor arena. This clinic will focus on basic reining techniques and reining patterns in the morning and the western riding/programmed ride patterns in the afternoon. This clinic will cost \$5.00 for half day participation and \$10.00 for full day. Proceeds will go toward arena fees and for the 2011 Laramie County Horse Show awards. The morning clinic will run 8:00am –12:00pm with check-in beginning at 7:30am, while the afternoon clinic will run 1:00pm-5:00pm with 12:30 check-in. Lunch will not be provided. Participants needing Safety Certification and their Speed Endorsement may be able to meet these requirements by attending one of these clinics.

All clinic participants must have a responsible party, over the age of 18, in attendance any un-chaperoned participants will be excused and their fee(s) will be forfeited. Additionally, all LCCC Agriculture Complex Rules and 4-H Rules will be strictly enforced. ## Cheyenne Saddle Tramps Meeting Minutes

April 20, 2011 LCCC AG Room 118 7:00 pm  
Meeting called to order: 7:15 PM by President Jody Osban  
Minutes approved from last meeting.

**President:** Jody Osban. Introduced Lanae Koons, Horse Show Chair and Kim Scott, Horse Show Secretary. Easterwood was a good show - good turnout. Robin did great job running it.

**Vice President:** Todd Miller. Not Present.

**Secretary:** Heidi King. Has printed entry forms, will print numbers, order ribbons, will fix shadow box, trail course mail box, spent a couple hours cleaning crows nest after Easterwood, everything seems to be in good shape and ready to go for the season. Don't forget to complete a Volunteer Hour Tracking form if you do any volunteering at a show, gymkhana, work night, etc. They are available on our website or in the crows nest.

**Treasurer:** Robert Fecht. Would like to implement a "No Cash" policy for money collected due to security concerns. Presently, there are no checks and balances for Treasurer, so from now on he will send secretary copy of every check that was written with the monthly financial report. 2nd half of property taxes are due. Check book balance \$6397.80. We have a new insurance company due to lack of response from prior company.

**Horse Show:** Lanae Koons. Coach of LCCC Equestrian Team. Wants to see volunteers to sign up a show or two prior to the show they are volunteering for. Will have show secretary, announcer, and judges set up. Would like to have a show etiquette clinic. Has been a judge at CST for two or three years and the show etiquette at CST needs to be improved. Needs ring stewards and gate keepers for first horse show on May 30th. Volunteers: Jordan and Halley will be ring stewards for first show, Robin Rinker will do gate for english show, Troy Griffith and Mark Rinker will do gate for western show. If you would like to volunteer for a show, please contact Lanae or Heidi King, CST Secretary.

**Gymkhana:** Robin Rinker. After practicing at the Easterwood show, she will be running the gymkhana's in "at-will" order per division. It seemed to run a lot quicker. She needs volunteers to do the gate for the first gymkhana. The Easterwood show brought in \$770.00 in entry fees and \$410.00 in membership fees.

**Concessions:** Chris Haas, Cat Casquerelli. They made \$120.00 at Easterwood! Will have breakfast items for first show.

**Grounds:** Tammy Maas. Not present, but sent report. Need new grounds chair. Heidi will make sure that stalls are ready for CFD. Bob and Emilee will coordinate reservations. Heidi will hold a work night on Thursday April 28th from 6:00 - 8:00. Emergency electrical work done recently at clubhouse due to exposed wiring. Lisa will run tractor at horse shows and gymkhanas if tractor is fixed.

**Advisor:** Michelle Martinez. Will audit Easterwood show records.

**3-D Barrels:** Amanda Kroul. Trying to get sponsors for a trophy saddle for 3-D barrels for an overall highpoint winner. Will club cover cost if not able to pay for trophy saddle? Motion, second, and unanimous approval to allow up to \$1000 to cover trophy saddle cost if not enough sponsorship is received. Jody will call Terry Liley to see if he can run tractor for 3-D barrels. May 7th is first 3-D.

**Royalty Advisor:** Victoria Hall. Not Present.

**Royalty:** 2011 Queen Jordan Rudolph. 2011 Princess Halley Jankovsky. No report.

**Parades:** Emilee Fecht. Vote on parades today. Proposed: CFD, Laramie Jubilee July 16th, Pine Bluffs August 6th, Wood Choppers June 18th, Greeley Stampede or Wellington July 4th. After discussion, decided to only do CFD, Pine Bluffs, and possibly Wood Chopper's due to high cost of gas. Royalty will ride in queens float in Greeley parade. Will have clinics. Heidi received quote from Colour Graphics for a new CST flag. She suggested two CST flags to give more people the chance to carry a flag in the parades and grand entries. Motion, second and unanimous approval to purchase two CST flags at approximately \$150 each. She also suggested purchasing new flag poles, and found wood poles online for approximately \$20 each. Motion, second and unanimous approval to purchase four new flag poles at approximately \$20 each.

**Rules:** Casey Griffith. Made a suggestion that if any ideas come up throughout the year for changes to the rules and constitution for next year, please email the suggestions to Casey or Heidi, so they can keep a record of them and have available for next year's rules committee.

**Clinician:** Michelle Martinez. Trail clinic in conjunction with 4H went really well - great turnout. Will set up an evening clinic in May (after the 10th) for a horse show etiquette clinic with Michelle and Lanae. Susan has another 4H/CST clinic planned for May 22 at LCCC.

**Drill:** Emilee Fecht. First meeting is April 25th. No horses for first meeting. 5:30 at CST Grounds.

Sponsorship/Fundraiser: Open.

**Website:** Jay Ostby. Not Present.

**Old Business:** All-Around saddle needs to be ordered. Amanda will check to see if we could get a discounted price if we purchase it and the 3-D Barrel saddle together.

**New Business:** Junior Board Report: will do fun classes at next horse show on lunch break and just before the gymkhana. Did research on bracelets and can design their own to sell at CST Events and schools, etc.
